Be creative and have fun!

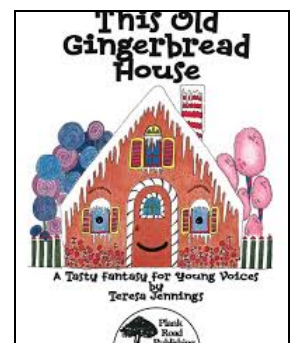
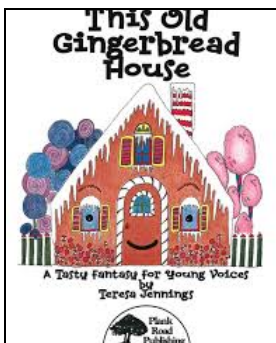
The 2nd grade performance date is Tuesday, December 17th, 2024 at 7:00 pm in the OLD Middle School Gym (401 N, 8th Street)!

COSTUME SUGGESTIONS

Hansel: may be dressed like the original Hansel in the opera or short sleeve shirt, short pants with knee length socks, etc. (see picture example)

Gretel: may be dressed like the original Gretel in the opera or simple dress & apron, etc. (see picture example)

Bob Thomas: plaid flannel shirt, jeans, suspenders, (beard optional)

Gnorm: plaid flannel shirt, jeans, apron, chef's hat, work shoes or boots, wooden spoon, etc. (see picture example)

TV Director: Red shirt (the word "Director" on it), small plastic megaphone, optional french mustache, hat & clapboard or dressed like the other TV crew members.

Narrators 1-15: Nice outfit or shirt with the word "Narrator #" Optional: tie, dress pants, dress, skirt & blouse, etc.

Neighbor 1-29: A woodland animal of your choice. Basic clothing: shirt & pants -gray, brown, black, etc. depending on color of animal. Examples: bird, bear, rabbit, raccoon, fox, deer, etc.

Action Neighbors: A woodland animal of your choice. Basic clothing: shirt & pants -gray, brown, black, etc. depending on color of animal. Examples: bird, bear, rabbit, raccoon, fox, deer, etc.

Spoken Solo's in Song 3 (Sorry) 1-12: A woodland animal of your choice. Basic clothing: shirt & pants -gray, brown, black, etc. depending on color of animal. Examples: bird, bear, rabbit, raccoon, fox, deer, etc.

Singing Solo in Song 4 (Everyone Deserves a Home): A woodland animal of your choice. Basic clothing: shirt & pants -gray, brown, black, etc. depending on color of animal. Examples: bird, bear, rabbit, raccoon, fox, deer, etc.

Action Bear: basic bear costume.

Action Rabbit: basic rabbit costume.

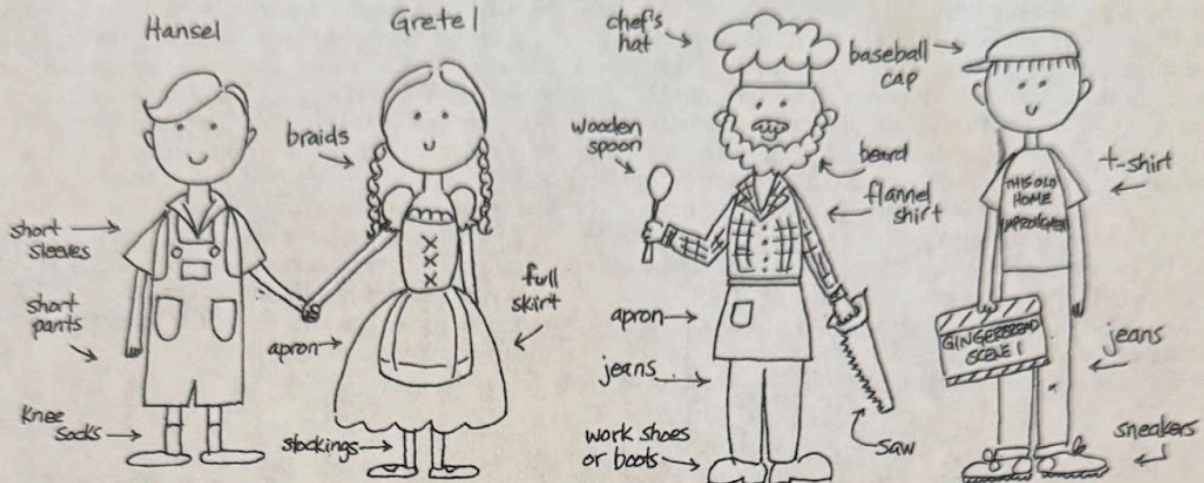
Action Crew/Camera Member of T.V. Show: Yellow t-shirt (optional "This Old Home Improvement" on it), jeans/pants, shoes, baseball cap (optional). **Camera Member:** (optional cardboard tv camera to hold and point)
